



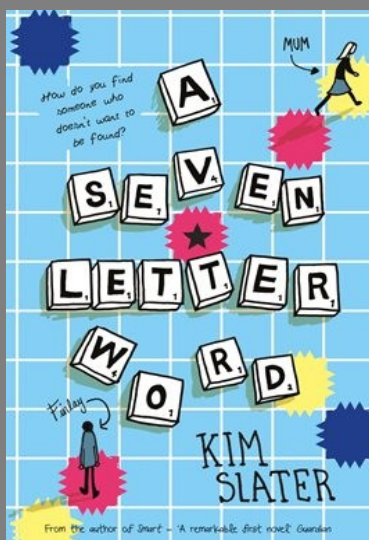

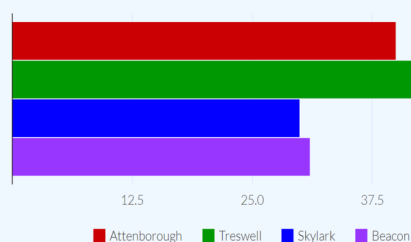
Our student-run library is open Monday and Wednesday lunchtimes.
