Healthy Breakfast Challenge is coming—on Friday 26 October students will battle it out to create the best brekkie!

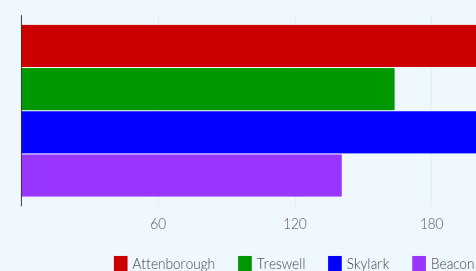


'WORK HARD, BE KIND' LIVES HERE!
