Dear Parents,

As we reach the end of a rather turbulent week and a rapidly evolving position in relation to educational settings, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you all with an update regarding some key aspects of our response to the national lockdown.

#### **Keeping in Touch**

In line with government guidelines and the requirement to minimise the number of staff on site and therefore minimise contacts, we have taken steps to amend our communications strategy. The admin office will therefore be 'closed' until further notice and all general communication should be directed via email to <a href="mailto:contact@suthersschool.co.uk">contact@suthersschool.co.uk</a> which will be monitored throughout the school day. To report urgent safeguarding concerns, call 01636 957690 and/or email us on the above address and a member of the safeguarding team will make contact with you. There will be a Designated Safeguarding Person on site every day.

## **Provision for Key Worker and Vulnerable Children**

Our school remains open to children of Key Workers and vulnerable children. We are working hard in school to maintain safe provision and minimise contacts and so please do only use this provision if it is an absolute necessity. **To request a place for your child** from Monday 11 January please **complete the online survey by midday on Sunday 10 January**.

Please note that from Monday 11 January there will be no on-site catering provision and so all students attending will need to be provided with a packed lunch.

#### **Remote Learning**

I have been really impressed by the level of engagement students have shown in their first week of remote learning since the start of term and to see that the introduction of live lessons alongside prerecorded materials and assignments has been working well. As previously communicated, we will keep this provision under constant review and will provide updates whenever required. ### **Learning Resource Packs**

In order to provide students with the resources needed to learn as effectively as possible from home, work is underway to collate the most essential materials e.g. set texts for GCSE English and prepare a schedule for collection by parents / nominated adults. #### **Access to IT Equipment and Increased Data**

We have already loaned a significant number of devices to students who do not have access to one at home and are now reliant on any additional equipment we can secure as part of the DFE's laptop distribution scheme. A number of network providers are also offering additional support to schools, trusts and local authorities. ## **Student Wellbeing**

We will continue to support the mental health and wellbeing all of our students throughout this period of school closure through regular contact with staff. This will include 'live' and online interactions with teaching and support staff, as well as a weekly live Form Time every Wednesday (commencing 13/01/21). As previously, we will also be closely monitoring engagement and rates of participation in order that we can work together to safeguard the wellbeing of all our students. As previously suggested, collecting consent at whole school level is a time-consuming administrative job and we would therefore like to make sure this is completed in good time.
