Yorkshire Sculpture Park – Thursday 24th October 2018

I am delighted to inform you that we are running our first KS3 Art trip to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park this year as part of the Year 9 Art Course. This allows students to experience artwork in-situ in the outdoors as well as in a gallery outside of the classroom which is an important part of the course.

There are a wide range of artists in this stunning open air exhibitions ranging from Henry Moore to Alfredo Jarr. On the grounds of the park are also galleries that show a variety of artwork. During the visit students will take part in teacher led workshops to interact and understand the Art as well as documenting and making their own in response. In the afternoon, students will have the opportunity to explore the park independently within small groups to complete activities and walks.

This trip will take place on **Thursday 24th October**, departing from the school bus park at **8.45am**. We are due to return to school at **approximately 5.30pm**, therefore parents will be responsible for arranging transport home. The cost of the trip is £19 per student, which includes transport costs and park fees. Please note that if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium they will be offered a fully-funded place on the trip.
